Participants: Girls and boys born on or after 1st January 2014.

We are expecting to welcome young players from different countries.

Modus: 9 rounds Swiss. Girls and boys play in one group, but there will be two separate rankings. The tournament will be rated for DWZ (German grades).

The pairing will be done using the latest version of „Swiss-Chess“.

Rate of play: Each player has 60 minutes for 40 moves plus 15 minutes for the rest of the game.
The FIDE rules of chess apply.

Late arrivals: Players arriving more than 10 minutes after the scheduled start time for any round will lose by default.

DWZ grades: The DWZ at the 16th October 2022 determines the starting rank list

How to get to the venue by car:

possibility 1: Motorway A4 to Dresden, exit „Hellerau“. B6 (direction Bischofswerda) until roundabout „Fischbacher Kreuz“, then via Stolpen, Neustadt to Sebnitz.

possibility 2: Motorway A4 around Dresden, exit „Burkau“, then via Bischofswerda, Neustadt to Sebnitz.

In Sebnitz follow the road signs for Dolní Poustevna (CZE), take the last turn to the right before the German-Czech border. Following this road uphill will lead you to the „Kinder- und Erholungszentrum“ (KiEZ). There are also road signs for the KiEZ on that road.

How to get to the venue by train:

Take a train to Sebnitz. The station is 3 km away from the „Kinder- und Erholungszentrum (KiEZ)“.
